### Cruise Itinerary

#### Thursday 30th July 2026

This morning we depart Staffordshire and travel to Liverpool. We embark the beautiful Bolette our home for the next 8 nights.

#### Friday 31st July 2026 - At sea

A wonderful day at sea to relax and explore the fabulous facilities on Bolette, our floating hotel.

#### Saturday 1st August 2026 - Lerwick, Scotland ⚓

We arrive in Lerwick today, the friendly capital of the Shetland Islands. Lerwick is a bustling seaport with a wonderful natural harbour, which is ideal for exploring on foot. Close by are the soaring cliffs of Sumburgh Head, which are perfect for spotting various examples of marine life and as a RSPB nature reserve, there are colonies of various birdlife.

#### Sunday 2nd August 2026 - Bergen, Norway

From its picturesque location, nestled amidst fjords and mountains, to the iconic Bryggen Wharf, featuring colourful timbered houses and cobbled streets, Bergen offers a captivating blend of culture and nature. Views of the city and its surroundings can be seen from atop Mount Floyen and Mount Ulriken, reached via funicular railway and cable car, respectively, while the vibrant fish market is ideal for sampling fresh seafood and Bergen staples such as fish soup. During summer, you will have the opportunity to explore the city's hiking trails for remarkable views of the surrounding fjords.

#### Monday 3rd August 2026 - Olden, Norway ⚓

Today we arrive in Olden, a beautiful village nestled in the inner arm of Nordfjord, with sparkling green fjord waters framed by rolling meadows and towering cliff faces. Perhaps take one of the steepest cable cars in the world, Loen Skylift, which offers you the chance to be transported to the top of Mount Hoven in just a few exhilarating moments. This afternoon, we cruise the Nordfjord and Innvikfjord. Stretching over 66 nautical miles from the westernmost point in Norway, overlooking the Sunnmøre Alps, to Jostedalsgreen, the largest glacier in mainland Europe, picturesque Nordfjord has a postcard-perfect icy-blue waters framed by towering peaks covering in lush greenery.

## Itinerary Continued...

### Tuesday 4th August 2026 - Åndalsnes, Norway

Åndalsnes is often referred to as the 'Alp town by the fjord'. Located at the mouth of the Rauma River, and surrounded by mountains, the town is in one of the most scenic areas of Norway, and a natural starting point for forest walks and hikes to magnificent viewpoints. The Rauma Railway is considered to be one of the best railway routes in Europe, since it was constructed 100 years ago. Later this afternoon, we cruise one of the longest, and cleanest fjords in Norway, Romsdalsfjorden is framed by the majestic peaks and waterfalls of the Romsdalsalpen Mountains, which tower over lush green valleys and charming waterside villages. The fjord village of Isfjorden is situated at the innermost part of the fjord, and has an unspoilt charm, surrounded by some of Norway's most famous natural landmarks, such as Romsdalshorn and Trollveggen.

### Wednesday 5th - Thursday 6th August 2026 - At sea.

A couple days at sea, perhaps treat yourself to afternoon tea or a spa treatment.

### Friday 7th August 2026

Arrive back into Liverpool this morning, before making our way back to Staffordshire.
